

Health, Safety, Security and Environment (“HSSE”) Policy

Keppel Infrastructure Fund Management Pte Ltd (“KIFM”) as Trustee Manager of Keppel Infrastructure Trust (“KIT”), together with its Board ESG Committee (collectively, “the Group”) places the highest priority on HSSE in the pursuit of all its business activities.

This policy is built on the following principles:

- Every HSSE incident is preventable.
- HSSE is a core value and a line responsibility.
- Everyone is empowered to stop any unsafe work
- A strong safety culture is achieved through teamwork.
- A healthy worker is a safe worker.
- Security is an integral part of providing essential products and services.

This policy shall be adopted at its business premises and operations where the Group has effective control and influence. To fulfil this policy, it is committed to:

Culture and Leadership

1. Promote a strong HSSE culture.
2. Promote wellbeing and maintain a safe and healthy working environment for all stakeholders.
3. Continuous review and strengthening of HSSE governance.
4. Continually improve performance by setting and reviewing long term targets and monitor progress through performance management and audits.

Enablers

1. Provide adequate safety training to ensure a competent workforce.
2. Adopt safety best practices and strive to surpass industry standards.
3. Adopt a systematic HSSE management approach which enables continuous improvement.
4. Facilitate learning and sharing to prevent recurrence.

Best Practices

1. Report and investigate all HSSE accidents, incidents and near-misses in a timely manner in accordance with the HSSE Incident Reporting and Investigation Procedure, and ensure lessons learned are disseminated to prevent recurrence.
2. Adopt the highest security standards at the key installations.
3. Minimise environmental impact through the conservation of natural resources and reducing Greenhouse Gas (GHG) emissions, as well as complying with air emissions, trade effluents and waste discharge limits.
4. Comply with statutory legislations of the countries in which it operates.
